PRACTICAL ISSUES: THE BRAINSTORM

- Firstly: focus on quantity
- Don't discard 'wild ideas' in the early stages of the brainstorm
- Combine good ideas to get better ideas



PRACTICAL ISSUES: THE CHOICE

Take into account:

- Why is this research question relevant?

- Why do we want to know the answer on this research question?

= clinical relevance
