

2019 Medicines Shortages Survey results

3 168 total responses

Patients:

385 responses from 22 countries

47% of patients reported that they had experienced medicines shortages to their own person or by a family member

What solution was offered?

40% Substitution of the medicine

35% Other

13% Advised to miss one dose
