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Background

In intensive care unit (ICU), patients are frequently unable to take oral tablet and capsule due to invasive ventilation or sedation. Therefore medications are administered by nasogastric tube or jejunostomy. We conducted a study in 2017 to describe prescriptions and administrations of oral medications through nasogastric tube or jejunostomy. From this study, local prescriptions and administrations guidelines were implemented in ICU by clinical pharmacy team.



The guidelines' implementation in ICU for patients with oral medications through jejunostomy or nasogastric tube improved quality of prescriptions and administrations. However, improvements are still possible involving clinical pharmacy student to support guidelines.



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
