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



- **❖** The registrar was trained in all areas include in the CTP.
- In the assessment areas, the following score was obtained:
 - Evaluation and selection of drugs (2.3)
 - Inventory management (1.9)
 - Masterful formulation (2.8)
 - Validation of the prescribing and dispensing of drugs (2.6)
 - Drug information and health products (2.4)
 - Artificial nutrition (2.1)
 - Outpatient pharmaceutical care (2.7)
 - Direction and management of PS (1.9)

The average overall assessment of the evaluated areas was 2.33, thus reaching a level of training listed as "optimal".
