#### Contribute from the HP to the management of inhalers to minimize environmental impact by:

- 1. Exploring the prevalence of correct inhaler disposal at the SIGRE waste collection point.
- 2. Evaluating factors related to better management of these pharmaceutical waste.
- 3. Analyzing whether patient intervention improves this management.

Multidisciplinary, multicenter project (42 centers), prospective in asthma patients under biological treatment.
