







# MEDICAL DEVICES VIGILANCE NETWORK: EXPERIENCE IN AN ITALIAN LOCAL HOSPITAL

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#### WHAT WAS DONE?

In October 2022 the Ministry of Health developed

## **DISPOVIGILANCE**

a new tool that supports Health System's vigilance network

Any event or suspect event that occurs with a medical device (MD) is classified as "incident" and it has to be notified to Ministry of Health

We collected incident reports of MDs in our hospital from January 2023 to October 2024

#### WHY WAS IT DONE?

To analyse the MDs involved in incident in an italian local hospital, since the introduction of Dispovigilance

## HOW WAS IT DONE?

Stratifying the incident reports by:

- risk classes (I, II, IIa, IIb, III, IA);
- CND (National Classification of Medical Devices);
  - type of reporter.

Data were collected in an Excel database

## WHAT WAS CONCLUDED?

- MDs reporting in our hospital is well stratified for both risk class and CND;
  - Injection cannulas have been involved in 24% of all incidents

We substituted them, in order to protect patient and healthcare worker's safety;

• Nurses are the major reporters and there is undereporting between clinicians

We sensibilized them to importance of reporting incidents or suspect incidents occurring with medical devices;

• From 2023 and 2024 reporting has been increased probably due to implementation of Dispovigilance.

#### WHAT HAS BEEN ACHIEVED? Between January 2023–October 2024 we reported 41 incidents: 16 in 2023 25 in 2024 Classification incidents based on risk classes 2 (5%) 1 (2,5%) 1 (2,5%) **RISK CLASSES:** Class Is: sterile less critical devices, Class IIa: medium 19 (46%) risk devices; 18 (44%) Class IIb: medium/high risk devices; Class III: high risk devices; Class IA: active implantable devices. Classe IIa ■ Classe III ■ Classe Is CND: Classification incidents based on CND CND A: devices for administration and collection, CND C: 12 cardiocirculatory system devices; 10 CND F: devices for hemodyalisis; CND G: gastrointestinal system devices; CND J: active implantable devices; CND L: surgical instruments not disposable; CND U: urogenital system devices. CND A CND C CND F CNF G
