
# EAHP Statements of Hospital Pharmacy 2015-16 Survey Results (by question)

### S55 - The pharmacists in our hospital use evidence-based approaches to reduce the risk of medication errors


# Fig1. Percentage of respondents who indicated they did not have difficulty complying with the statement (positive responses)

# Fig2. What is preventing this? (results for all countries overall)


