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
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## Background

There are many medicinal products that, although having shown efficacy and safety in different ophthalmological indication, they are not authorized or commercially available for ophthalmic administration.



To evaluate the elaborations of ophthalmological medicines which must be prepared in the Pharmacy Service. **Material and methods** Retrospective study of ophthalmological Data source: **SAVAC**<sup>®</sup> computer system preparations in a reference hospital. The ophthalmological preparations in pharmacy hospital have increased a 19%. Autologous serum 20% and cyclosporine 0.05% were impacted of 92% eye drops, including the longest storage duration tested. They must be prepared in the Pharmacy Service according to quality criteria to ensure its effectiveness, stability and sterility<sup>1</sup> and supposed a high economic impact (260,816.76€)
