

A DIGITAL ASSISTANT TO SUPPORT PATIENTS IN PREPARING MEDICATION RECONCILIATION: PATIENT EXPERIENCES

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Relevance

- Medication reconciliation is standard care
- Online medication reconciliation preparation → improving medication reconciliation

Aim of the study

Ascertain the experiences of patients with a digital assistant for pre-visit online medication reconciliation

Method

- Prototype digital assistant
- Semi-structured individual interviews
- Neurology and rheumatology patients Elisabeth TweeSteden Hospital, May 2022
- Inductive thematic analysis



Results

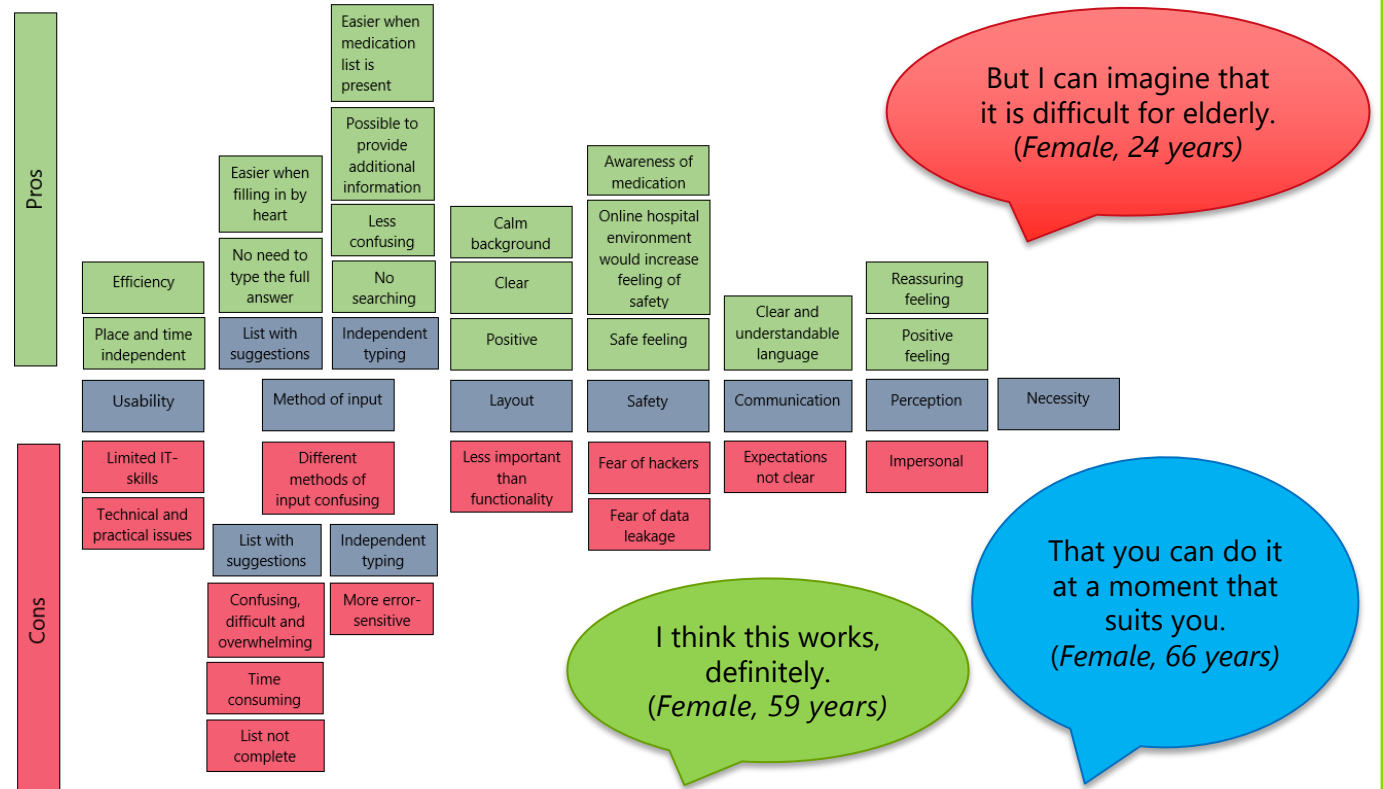


Figure 1: overview of the identified themes, categorized into pros and cons
