PURPOSE

The proper methods of storage of medicines are of great importance for maintenance of their stability and therefore their efficacy and safety. The aim of the study is to know household storage habits of oral drugs dispensed by the outpatient hospital pharmacy service.

- Duration: 1 month



- Knowledge about package insert conservation information content
- Conservation of original packaging and leaflet

COMPLETED; 1%


- ✓ Place of home storage

RESULTS

N: 185, mean (±SD)56 years (±14,7) > 49.7% patient didn`t have any studies

CONCLUSIONS

A significant proportion of patients presented an information gap regarding to drug storage conditions. Several wrong storage practices were identified.
