an original tool for assessing, promoting and improving your Patient Education Program

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Background and objectives

In France, assessment of patient education programs is a necessity to renew the agreement from health regional agencies, every year and at the end of every 4-year period.

The purpose of this work was to build an assessment tool of the process, the activity and the effects of a program, as expected by current French recommendations.

Results

The Excel form is made of first 4 input sheets: Identification, Process, Activity and Effects. A synthesis of the analysis is then automatically generated showing charts and scores about: strengths and weaknesses and qualitative or quantitative evolution data, so that the team is able to take a decision on the future of the program (a method is proposed on the "decision" last input sheet leading either to an action plan and continuation or cessation). Then, a report of the assessment process is created and can be printed.



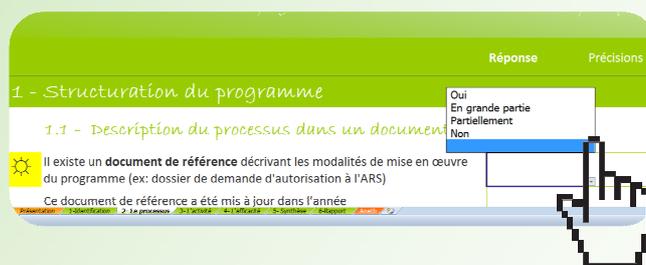
