

Country report GA 2022: Finnish Pharmacists' Association

The organisation of public healthcare, social welfare and rescue services will be reformed in Finland. The planning of the reform of social and health services has continued for years.

The responsibility for organising these services will be transferred from municipalities to wellbeing services counties from 2023. The key objective of the reform is to improve the availability and quality of basic public services throughout Finland.

Several small health care units, including hospital pharmacies, have been integrated into larger units to achieve the goals. Integration has accelerated facilities modernization and investment in automation of pharmaceutical distribution and manufacturing.

The changes that have taken place will continue for the next few years in different parts of Finland.
