

What is PARADIGM project?

PARADIGM is a public-private partnership that brings together 34 partners with the mission of developing a framework that enables structured, effective, meaningful, ethical, innovative, and sustainable patient engagement (PE) and demonstrates the 'return on the engagement' for all players. What is Delphi Modified technique?

It is a technique aimed at achieving consensus over a specific issue.

We use Modified Delphi technique to identify and prioritise expectations and preferences for patient engagement in medicine development lifecycle across all the parties involved. More specifically, we are studying patient engagement practices in three specific points in time: **research priorities setting**, **clinical trials design** and **early dialogues with regulators and HTA** (Health Technology Assessment) bodies.

We are looking for participants with **experience in one or more** of these 3 medicine development stages. The goal is to develop a set of measurable criteria to assess practices about patient engagement and the Delphi process is a critical step to get there.

The process consists of two consecutive online questionnaires (Round 1 and Round 2) aimed at reaching consensus over key issues and 1 face-to-face meeting (Round 3) in which prioritization of relevant issues is achieved.



What do we expect from you as an expert panellist?

As an expert panellist, you bring your unique perspective in patient engagement on medicine development lifecycle. We will ask you to:



Round 1 & 2: Fill in 2 consecutive online questionnaires

You will be asked to answer two questionnaires through an online platform where:

- your answers are recorded automatically
- you can save and continue the survey in multiple sessions, or edit your responses within the responding timeframe.

Completing a questionnaire will not take more than 40'.



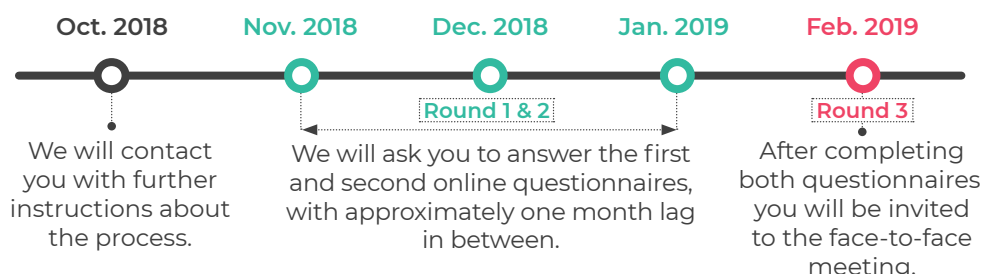
Round 3: Face-to-face meeting with other expert panellists

After completing both online questionnaires, you will be invited to the last step of the Delphi process; the face-to-face meeting with all other expert panellists.

The meeting will be held in Brussels in February 2019.
