Dear Kees,

We met with Sophie Weisswange today. She told us again that CTF is not a priority for the Commission. For the first time she brought up that the Commission favors deregulation. If we want to move ahead with CTF, which we absolutely want, the Commission would need to receive together with our application for the adoption of a Delegated Act evidence showing the benefit of a hospital pharmacy specialisation for patients.

On the one hand, Joan and Petr suggested to involve the GA delegates by asking them to share posters presented at their Congresses with us. On the other hand, Joan and Petr would like to encourage poster submissions for our own Congress that show measured patient benefit of hospital pharmacy activities. Both considered issuing a special 'award' for such posters. However, no sperate category should be created.

Do you think this would be feasible?

To make it easier for you, Joan suggested to have CTF Working Group 3 members review posters that are pre-selected by the SC.

Do you have any further ideas on how we could collect evidence that basically shows that patients benefit if treated by specialized hospital pharmacists?
