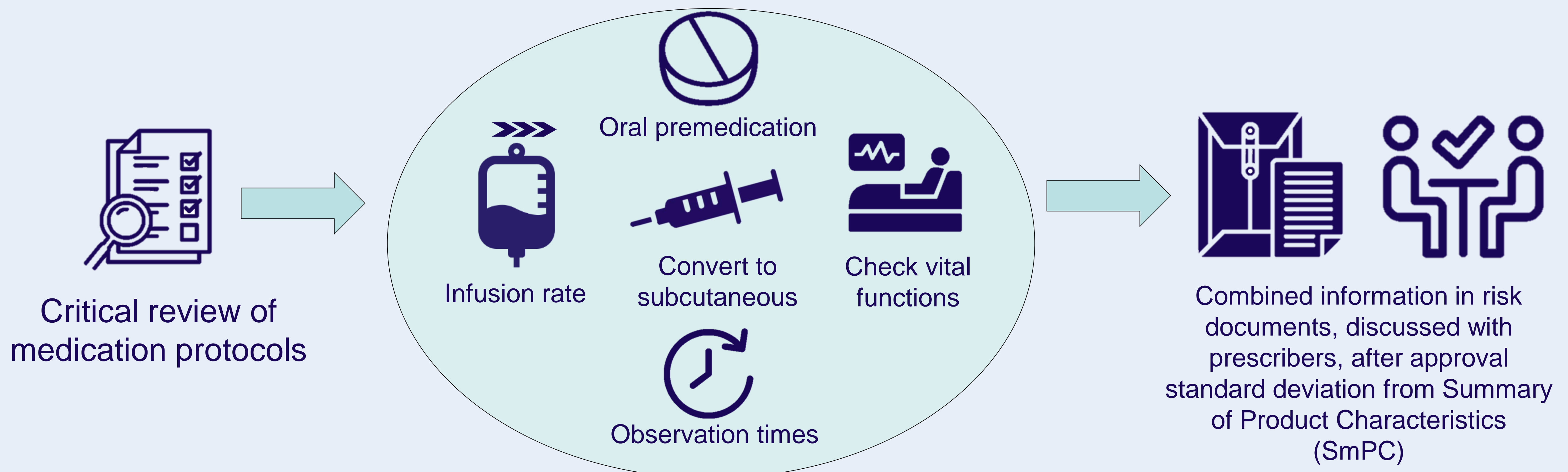

 ± 6000 hours**




