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What was done?:

New clinical pharmacy internship in immersion in pediatric intensive care unit for 5th year students

At the interface between medical and pharmaceutical teams.

Establish a statement to analyze the drug management, its evaluation and improvement



















Why was it done?:

- Discover and understand pediatrics and intensive care: less covered in university teaching
 - > Proof of concept to develop this type of internship in other departments



How was it done?:

Full-time employee, fully integrated into the medical team Morning: attend the relief, the staff and the medical visit

Afternoon: performs a reading of present patients compiling main medical, clinical and biological information


> Pre-validate pharmaceutically the medical prescriptions and propose pharmaceutical interventions (PI)











What has been achieved?:

Systematically chosen by the students since its opening: 8 students in 3 years Training period of 1 month with the senior pharmacist: all students able to perform the expected readings, pre-validation and Pl.

→ 78% of the PIs detected by the students were validated by the senior pharmacist and accepted by the physician















Proof of concept:

- Students are supportive of this type of initiative
- Able to meet the high expectations of this internship
