Exceptional health situations: observation of an immersive exercise in the hospital pharmacy and feedback



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What was done and why?

In March 2024, our hospital pharmacy (HP) took part in an interdepartmental exercise based on the scenario of managing a massive influx of polytrauma victims at our hospital.

Quick engagement of mobile medical units and sterilization department, dependent on the HP, is a key element in the optimal care of victims, whether in hospital or pre-hospital.



Scenario:



- 2 8:30 AM Collapse of a ceiling in a gymnasium in Nantes
- W Hundreds of victims where 12 victims treated in the operating room
- Activation of the Hospital Crisis Unit (H-CU) and Operational Units (OU)



Main objectives: To test the activation of our Pharmacy-Sterilization-Operational-Unit (PS-OU), established in December 2022, and to work on its interaction with the others OU of the different hospital services. The second aim was to continue the training of pharmaceutical teams on exceptional health situations (EHS).

How was it done?

- Two interns and one pharmacy technician as observers through the exercise
- Analysis framework created and completed during the exercise
- Feedback questionnaire was sent to the 9 mains players (PS-OU members, oncall pharmacist...)
- Intra-HP and inter-departmental feedback were provided immediately, then a posteriori



During the PS-OU activation, various points were observed:



- Global crisis management
- Task assignment and communication between the members
- Data centralization and communication with the others OU
- Efficiency and speed of response to problems...

What has been achieved?



For 3 hours, our HP had activated its OU to provide the best possible response to this exercise. 9 main players feedbacks (89% answered)








